Project Name: Colerain Rd./Future SR 40 Bypass

Brief Description: The Georgia Department of Transportation is currently in the process of developing a project to widen existing Colerain Road to four lanes for future coordination of SR 40 Bypass.

Project Location: The project is located north of the cities of Kingsland and St. Mary's. It begins at Interstate 95 and continues east to Kings Bay Road.

Proposed Project Description: The project proposes to widen Colerain Road/ CR 90 to a typical section of two 12-foot lanes in each direction separated by a 20-foot raised median. It will provide a 10-foot multi-use path on the north side and a 5-foot sidewalk on the south side to meet Camden County's bike route system requirements for Colerain Road. The substantial residential development planned for this area would use the sidewalks to the nearby county high school.

Preconstruction or Construction Info: Currently the project is in the right-of-way phase. Final plans will proceed while right-of-way is being purchased to construct the project.
