Brief, general description: The project proposes to widen SR92 from 2 to 4 lanes in Paulding and Cobb counties. The project limits are from just north of SR 120 to Old Burnt Hickory Road.

Project Location: The project is in eastern Paulding County and western Cobb County, along the existing highway alignment between SR 120 and Old Burnt Hickory Road.

Proposed Project Description: The proposed project would begin just north of SR 120 and extend into Paulding and Cobb counties along the existing SR 92 alignment to Old Burnt Hickory Road. The project typical section is projected to be 4-lanes with a raised median and curb and gutter. A sidewalk or multi-use path is also proposed. Roundabouts will be proposed as intersection improvements at Due West Road, Due West Street, and Old Burnt Hickory Road. The project is approximately 8 miles long.

Preconstruction Info: The concept report is under development. A Practical Alternatives Report has been prepared and submitted to the US Army Corps of Engineers.
