Brief, general description: The Georgia Department of Transportation is in final design for the proposed widening of US 84/SR 38 in Ware County from just west of Greasy Branch to just west of CR 88/Ruskin Road.

Project Location: The proposed project is southwest of Waycross, GA in Ware County. This project would widen US 84/SR 38 from just west of Greasy Branch to just west of CR 88/Ruskin Road for a length of approximately 8 miles.

Proposed Project Description: The project proposes to widen US 84/SR 38 from 2 to 4 lanes with a 32-foot depressed, grassed median. The proposed alignment follows the existing highway for the length of the project. The project begins just west of Greasy Branch and ends just west of CR 88/Ruskin Road. The project will also replace the existing bridges at Greasy Branch, Little Alligator Creek, and Big Alligator Creek.
