

#### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Project HPP00-0000-00(265), Fulton County, is the addition of a multi-use path along Hardscrabble Road. The City of Roswell is sponsoring this federally funded project for the construction of a portion of the Roswell Green Loop Path. This Phase 1 portion proposes the addition of a multi-use path between King Road and Etris Road. Other proposed improvements consist of sidewalks, pedestrian crossings, and intersection improvements, including a roundabout at the intersection of Hardscrabble Road and the eastern leg of Chaffin Road.
