

GENERAL PROJECT LOCATION/ DESCRIPTION
PROJECT STP00-0000-00(421), GLYNN COUNTY

Project STP-0000-00(421) in Glynn County is proposed to widen the State Route (SR) 25 Spur from two lanes to four lanes from just north of Cate Road to SR 99. A section of SR 99 on both sides of the SR 25 Spur intersection would also be widened. Total project length includes 2.1 miles of SR 25 Spur and 0.74 miles of SR 99. The design speed is 55 mph.

The existing typical section has two 12' lanes with a 5' grass shoulder on approximately 225' to approximately 290' of Glynn County Right of Way. The existing roadway is maintained by Glynn County.

The proposed typical state route rural section will consist of 12 foot outside lanes and 11 foot inside lanes in each direction; a 32 foot depressed grassed median; 10 foot bikeable outside shoulders, which consists of 6.5 foot paved and 3.5 foot grassed; 6 foot inside shoulders of which 2 foot is paved and 4 foot is grassed; and roadside ditches. The proposed right of way will vary from approximately 225' to approximately 290'. Ownership and maintenance of project will be assumed by the Georgia Department of Transportation at project completion.
