
## NHS-0000-00(691), Candler County, PI 0000691 New Rest Area in I-16 Median

## **Project Description**

The project consists of construction of a new rest area within GDOT right-of-way in the median of I-16 at approximately Mile Post 97. The new facility will be located approximately 7.0 miles west of the City of Metter and just west of the interchange of I-16 and SR 57. The purpose of this project is to construct a facility along I-16 that could be used as an information center or relief center during an evacuation for thousands of people from the Georgia coastal areas. As a result, the GDOT has determined that there is a need for a facility between Savannah and Macon that could be used as an information center, command center or as a relief site for thousand of travelers during an evacuation.

The project would include the construction of two new bridges that would "scissor" (the mainline eastbound and westbound directions) so that ingress to and from the rest area site would be provided on the right hand side of the mainline along both directions of I-16. West of the site, the eastbound mainline is proposed to bridge over the westbound mainline. East of the site, the westbound mainline is proposed to bridge over the eastbound mainline. As a result, in the vicinity of the rest area site, traffic would travel in the appropriate direction for right-hand exit and entrance ramps. The rest area would include office space, display station area, restroom facilities, parking areas, picnic areas, lighting, landscaping, overflow parking for hurricane evacuation, and water and sewer systems. The mainline detours would be constructed on temporary easement and no additional right-of-way would be required.

The proposed project would also include the construction of approximately 7.5 miles of water line to connect to the City of Metter water system and a sewer treatment facility on site. This would provide water and sewer services to the proposed rest area and would be constructed within the exiting right-of-way along SR 46 and I-16.
