

## **Project Description:**

Project STP-0001-00(818) consists of grade separating the existing at grade railroad crossing number 904053X of SR 16 and the Norfolk Southern Railroad just east of the Griffin city limits in Spalding County. The proposed project would construct a new SR 16 bridge over the Norfolk Southern Railroad and Green Valley Road (CR 67) that runs parallel to the railroad. This rail line is part of the future Atlanta to Macon Commuter Rail system. The project extends along SR 16 from the east side of the Wilson Road (CR 55) intersection to approximately 0.25-mile east of Barrow Road (CR 74). SR 16 will remain as a four thru lane roadway but will be widened from a 13-ft. flush median with a two way left turn lane (TWLTL) to a 24-ft raised median. The 24-ft. raised median will transition to a 13-ft. flush median near Wilson Road and a 44-ft. depressed median east of Barrow Road.
