Thank you for attending the Public Information Open House for the proposed Waycross East Bypass, PI Number 0002871. Our goal is two-fold: 1) to provide you with information on the proposed project and 2) to provide an opportunity for you to give us your comments on the proposed project. While you are attending the open house, you can **provide your comments today** by filling out the comment card provided with this handout and dropping it in the comment box, or you may choose to provide your verbal comments to the court reporter who will transcribe your comments.

The comment period ends on Friday, August 28, 2015. Follow the steps below to provide your comments online.

 - 1. From the menu, select the county in which the proposed project is located and click Go;
 - 2. Select Waycross East Bypass;
 - 3. Lastly, click *Comment* and follow the instructions to leave your comments.
- Mail in your comment card to Ms. Hiral Patel, P.E., Georgia Department of Transportation, 600 West Peachtree Street NW, 16th Floor, Atlanta, GA 30308.

During the comment period, the project displays and plans will be available for review at the website noted above. Hardcopies will also be available in the Georgia DOT Waycross Area Office located at 104 North Nichols Street, Waycross, GA 31501. 

Why We Are Here: The Morningside Drive/City Boulevard corridor is the only existing north-south route connecting US 1/US 23 to US 84. This route requires drivers to make dog-leg turns and is the cause of traffic congestion through town, on local streets, and in residential areas.

Commercial and residential developments are expanding along the US 1/US 23 corridor southeast of Waycross. Residential development is also occurring along the US 84 corridor northeast of Waycross. These development trends are expected to continue, and will affect local travel patterns and traffic congestion on existing roadways.

The purpose of this project is to improve the travel conditions within the City of Waycross on Morningside Drive, City Boulevard, US 84, US 1/US 23, and to reduce the frequency and severity of crashes along these roadways. In addition, the project would accommodate the economic growth patterns in the area, move truck traffic off City streets, reduce cut-through traffic in residential neighborhoods, and improve regional north-south connectivity.

Project Description: The Waycross East Bypass would be a new roadway, about 5.4 miles long. One end would connect to US 1/US 23 about 3.6 miles southeast of downtown Waycross, and the other end would connect to US 84 about 3.3 miles northeast of downtown Waycross. The roadway would be four lanes wide between its intersections with US 1/US 23 and US 82. It would be two lanes wide between US 82 and US 84. Required right-of-way would be 200 feet for the four-lane section and 120 feet for the two-lane section. A bridge – about 3/4 mile long – would be built over the Satilla River to protect this sensitive environmental area.
