Thank you for attending the combined public information open house and detour open house for GDOT Project STP00-0003-00 (625) Bleckley County, P.I. No. 0003625, the proposed widening of the Cochran Bypass/State Route 87/U.S. 23 just south of the intersection of State Route 87 Business and extending to just north of the intersection with State Route 87 Business. In this handout package you will find a project description, detour/project location map, and comment card.

As you enter the room, you will notice displays of the proposed project, as well as the project's proposed detour route. Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) representatives, who can be identified by the nametags they are wearing, are available to discuss the project and answer your questions. Comments can also be made via the web at www.dot.ga.gov. Click on Public Outreach from the Information Center dropdown menu at the top right side of the page. All comments will be made a part of the project record. We hope you will take advantage of one of these opportunities to let GDOT know your view of the proposal.

The displays and plans will be available for review for ten days after the public information open house at the Georgia Department of Transportation Area Engineers Office located at 2003 Highway 441 South, Dublin, Georgia 31021. A copy of all comments received will be available for public review at this same location and at the Georgia Department of Transportation, Office of Environment Services, 600 West Peachtree Street NW, 16th Floor, Atlanta, Georgia 30308, as soon as compilation is completed.



GDOT Project STP00-0003-00 (625), Bleckley County is the widening and reconstruction of the Cochran Bypass/State Route (SR) 87/US 23 from just south of the intersection of SR 87 Business and extending to just north of the intersection with SR 87 Business. The project limits will connect the four-lane section with 14-ft. flush median on the south side of Cochran to the existing four-lane section to the north of Cochran. The project will also provide a grade-separated crossing (railroad overpass bridge) at Norfolk Southern Railroad. The proposed roadway shall consist of two 12-ft. travel lanes in each direction separated by a 14-ft. flush median with 10-ft rural shoulders. Four feet of the shoulder will be paved. During construction, traffic will be detoured off site while the bridge over the Norfolk Southern Railroad crossing is being completed.
