MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION, GEORGIA DIVISION AND

GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION REGARDING

RESPONSIBILITIES AND COMMITMENTS FOR ENVIRONMENTAL PROCESS PROGRAM/PROJECT ACTIONS

FOR FEDERAL-AID HIGHWAY PROJECTS

WHEREAS, the Stewardship and Oversight Agreement on Project Assumption and Program Oversight identifies the authorities and responsibilities of the FHWA Georgia Division (FHWA) and Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) with respect to Title 23 project approvals and related responsibilities, and federal-aid highway program oversight activities; and

WHEREAS, the FHWA and GDOT Office of Environmental Services (OES) agree that a written understanding of responsibilities and commitments of each party for implementing the processes associated National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and other environmental law compliance is beneficial to both parties; and

WHEREAS, both parties agree that the preparation of technically complete and sufficient studies and documents is critical to minimizing inefficiencies and costs of the environmental process and assuring regulatory compliance; and

WHEREAS, GDOT is responsible for the quality and completeness of documents submitted to FHWA, including those prepared by Local Public Agencies; and

WHEREAS, FHWA is responsible for the legal sufficiency of environmental documents; and

WHEREAS, FHWA is responsible for timely responses to GDOT requests for FHWA action;

WHEREAS, GDOT may rely upon the FHWA response times listed below for project baseline schedule development; and

WHEREAS, FHWA and GDOT have consulted and agreed to the commitments listed below for the specific activities required by each party as part of the environmental process.

TERMINATION/ AMENDMENT

1. This Agreement may be modified by mutual consent at any time.

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- Any party to this Agreement may request that it be amended, whereupon the parties will consult to reach a consensus on the proposed amendment. Where no consensus can be reached, the Agreement will not be amended.
- 3. Any signatory to this Agreement may terminate it by providing thirty (30) days written notice to the other party, provided that the signatories and concurring parties consult during the period prior to termination to seek Agreement on amendments or other actions that would avoid termination.

DISPUTE RESOLUTION

The Dispute Resolution process described in the Stewardship and Oversight Agreement on Project Assumption and Program Oversight between FHWA and GDOT will be implemented in the event of a dispute between the signatory parties to this Agreement.

APPROVAL OF AGREEMENT

The undersigned have reviewed this Agreement and determined that it complies with the laws, regulations, and policies applicable to FHWA and GDOT. Accordingly, it is hereby approved and becomes effective on the last date noted below.
