A RESOLUTION

Designating and naming State Highway Route No. 12 the Alexander H. Stephens Highway.

WHEREAS Alexander H. Stephens was loved, honored, and revered not only throughout this State, but throughout the entire nation, as well as throughout the nations of the world, as a statesman and a patriot, and as one possessing the highest virtues of intellect and heart; and whereas his home is located in the City of Crawfordville where it is maintained as a shrine to his immortal memory; and whereas his memory has first place in the love and affection of the people of this State, and particularly of those in the section of the State in which he was born and reared and which is traversed by State Highway Route No. 12, which runs from the City of Atlanta to the City of Augusta, passing through the cities of Conyers, Covington, Madison, Greensboro, Crawfordville, and Thomson.

THEREFORE be it resolved by the Senate of the State of Georgia, the House of Representatives concurring, that State Highway Route No. 12 be and the same is hereby named and designated the Alexander H. Stephens Highway.
