ANDREW JACKSON HIGHWAY — DESIGNATED.

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, in his march to Florida during the Seminole Indian Wars, General Andrew Jackson substantially followed the route now followed by State Highway or Route No. 11 from Rabun Gap to the City of Lakeland, Georgia; and

WHEREAS it is fitting and proper that the State of Georgia make some recognition of this American patriot, who was a gallant soldier, a great statesman, and an illustrious democrat.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the General Assembly (the Senate and House of Representatives concurring), that State Route or Highway No. 11 be and the same is hereby designated as the "Andrew Jackson Highway."

[Sidenote: Route No. 11 designated as Andrew Jackson Highway.]

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the State Highway Department be and it is hereby authorized and empowered to suitably mark said highway.
