TENNESSEE-COLUMBUS MILITARY HIGHWAY — DESIGNATED.

No. 50.

A RESOLUTION

To provide that the part of the highway known as State Route No. 1, which extends from the Tennessee State line to the City of Columbus in Muscogee County, shall be known, designated, and maintained as a military highway.

BE IT RESOLVED by the General Assembly of Georgia:

Section 1

That so much of State Route No. 1 as extends from the Tennessee State line through the City of Rome, the City of Cedartown, the City of Carrollton, the City of LaGrange, and to the City of Columbus in Muscogee County, shall hereafter be known, designated, and maintained as a military highway.

[Sidenote: Military highway between Columbus and Tennessee.]

Section 2

That the State Highway Board is hereby directed to so designate and maintain that part of said State Route No. 1 herein described as a military highway, in conformity with the laws relating to such highway.
