Senate Resolution

Effective March 15, 1935.

ALEXANDER H. STEPHENS HIGHWAY — DESIGNATED.

A RESOLUTION

Designating the Alexander H. Stephens Highway; and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, Alexander H. Stephens was loved, honored, and revered not only throughout this State, but throughout the entire nation, as well as throughout the nations of the world, as a statesman and a patriot, and as one possessing the highest virtues of intellect and heart; and

WHEREAS, his home is located in the City of Crawfordville where it is maintained as a shrine to his immortal memory; and whereas his memory has first place in the love and affection of the people of this State, and particularly of those in the section of the State in which he was born and reared and which is traversed by State Highway Route 12, which runs from the City of Atlanta to the City of Augusta, passing through the cities of Conyers, Covington, Madison, Greensboro, Crawfordville, and Thomson.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF GEORGIA, the House of Representatives concurring, that the portion of State Highway Route 12, from the city of Atlanta, through the cities of Conyers, Covington, Madison, Greensboro, Crawfordville, and Thomson, to the city of Augusta, be designated as the Alexander H. Stephens Highway.
