Senate Resolution

Effective March 28, 1935

ANDREW JACKSON HIGHWAY — DESIGNATED.

A RESOLUTION

Designating the Andrew Jackson Highway; and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, in his march to Florida during the Seminole Indian Wars, General Andrew Jackson substantially followed the route now followed by State Highway or Route No. 11 from Rabun Gap to the City of Lakeland, Georgia; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that the State of Georgia make some recognition of this American patriot, who was a gallant soldier, a great statesman, and an illustrious democrat.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF GEORGIA, the House of Representatives concurring, that the portion of State Route or Highway 11, from Rabun Gap, to the city of Lakeland, be designated as the "Andrew Jackson Highway."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the State Highway Department be and it is hereby authorized and empowered to suitably mark said highway.
