Resolution

Effective March 23, 1935

TENNESSEE – COLUMBUS MILITARY HIGHWAY — DESIGNATED.

A RESOLUTION

Designating the Tennessee-Columbus Military Highway; and for other purposes.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA, that the portion of State Route 1, from the Georgia-Tennessee state line, through the cities of Rome, Cedartown, Carrollton, and Grange, to the city of Columbus in Muscogee County, be designated as a military highway, Tennessee – Columbus Military Highway.

[Sidenote: Military highway between Columbus and Tennessee.]

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the State Highway Board is hereby directed to so designate and maintain that part of said State Route No. 1 herein described as a military highway, in conformity with the laws relating to such highway.
