A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Sidney Lanier, an outstanding Georgia poet, in his poem, "Song of the Chattahoochee", immortalized the beauties of the Chattahoochee River, which river rises in Habersham County.

BE IT RESOLVED by the General Assembly of Georgia, that the bridge over the Chattahoochee River between Habersham and White Counties, be named The Sidney Lanier Bridge, and the State Highway Department is hereby authorized and directed to mark said bridge with a suitable plaque or marker, in cooperation with the civic organization of Habersham County, said plaque or marker to bear the following inscription.

"Dedicated to the Memory of Sidney Lanier."
