**BLUE STAR DRIVE — DESIGNATED.**

**A RESOLUTION**

To establish a memorial to the sons and daughters of Georgia who have served their State and Nation so valiantly in time of war by designating Blue Star Drive as such a memorial.

WHEREAS The Garden Club of Georgia is desirous of designating U. S. Highway No. 1 in Georgia as Blue Star Drive to commemorate the services of her sons and daughters in time of war, and wishes to beautify the Blue Star Drive when so designated by planting shrubbery, establishing parks, picnic grounds and in other ways; and

WHEREAS The National Council of Garden Clubs is sponsoring a nation-wide movement to establish such memorial drives, and, at its suggestion, many States have already accomplished this end by designating U. S. Highway No. 1 within their limits as Blue Star Drive; and

WHEREAS it is fitting and proper that such a dedication be made at this time.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the General Assembly of Georgia that that portion of United States Highway No. 1 which lies within the boundaries of the State of Georgia be and it is hereby designated as Blue Star Drive as a memorial to the brave sons and daughters of this State who served her so valiantly in time of war.
