BRACK BRIDGE — DESIGNATED.

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Honorable George Washington Brack and his wife, Ethel Ellington Brack, were both life-long citizens of Wilkinson County and both descendants of the first pioneers who settled Wilkinson County, and throughout their lives were held in high esteem by citizens of Wilkinson County and surrounding counties; and

WHEREAS, the lives of both of these honorable citizens were spent near a certain bridge across Turkey Creek, near Allentown, Georgia; and

WHEREAS a new bridge is now being built by the State Highway Department near the home where these exceptionally good citizens lived so long; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that they be honored in some way.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring, that the new bridge over Turkey Creek, near Allentown, Georgia, be named and designated as the "Brack Bridge" in memory and in honor of George Washington Brack and Ethel Ellington Brack.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the proper authorities are hereby authorized and directed to so name and designate said bridge and to erect suitable markers thereon.
