JACK BROWN ROAD — DESIGNATED.

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, a new road for paving has been projected, starting at the new Health Center in Irwinton, Georgia and running for a distance of about three miles to Wriley, Georgia, on the Central of Georgia Railroad; and

WHEREAS, on this stretch of road there is what is known as the "Jack Brown Hill," so named because two of the best citizens of Wilkinson County made their home on that hill for many years; and

WHEREAS, Carrie McCranie Tarpley Brown was the wife of Jack Brown, it is considered fit and proper that this road be named in memory and honor of Carrie McCranie Tarpley Brown and Jack Brown.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring, that the road laid from the Health Center in the City of Irwinton to Wriley, Georgia be named and designated as the "Jack Brown Road."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the proper authorities are hereby empowered and directed to so name and designate said road and to erect suitable markers thereon.
