A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, there has recently been completed an improved portion of the highway system of Georgia presently known as the Loganville-Bold Springs-Winder Road; and

WHEREAS, this road traverses a section and serves a community that is dear to the heart of one of its native sons and great Georgians; and

WHEREAS, this said distinguished citizen has served his people in the practice of medicine since 1909 and is admired, respected and cherished by his friends and neighbors; and

WHEREAS, he has labored long and diligently to bring about the construction and improvement of said road and gave the weight of his prestige and influence to assure its completion.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the aforesaid length of road be now and forever hereinafter known as the Charles S. Floyd Road.
