JUDGE I. HOMER SUTTON BRIDGE — DESIGNATED.

A RESOLUTION

Designating a certain bridge as the "Judge I. Homer Sutton Bridge"; and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, Honorable I. Homer Sutton, a lifelong resident of Clarkesville, Georgia, in Habersham County, has devoted the greater part of his long and rich life to public service; and

WHEREAS, he served his State as a Judge in the Court of Appeals for a period of some 22 years, from May 28, 1932, to January 15, 1954, after which he served as a Justice of the Supreme Court of Georgia until his retirement in 1954; and

WHEREAS, Judge Sutton is one of the most beloved public figures in the State of Georgia and is loved by the people of all walks of life; and

WHEREAS, it is only fitting and proper that he be honored in some manner even though he can never be repaid for all the splendid service he has rendered his State and county.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the General Assembly of Georgia, that the bridge over the Soque River on the Burton Road in Habersham County at Clarkesville, Georgia, be hereby designated as the "Judge I. Homer Sutton Bridge."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the State Highway Department is hereby authorized and directed to designate said bridge as aforesaid, and to have placed on or near said bridge an appropriate sign bearing the name "Judge I. Homer Sutton Bridge."
