ROY HEAD BRIDGE — DESIGNATED.

No. 156 (House Resolution No. 461-1117c).

A RESOLUTION

To designate a certain bridge as the "Roy Head Bridge;" and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, the bridge known as the "Roy Head Bridge" on U. S. Route No. 129 about one (1) mile north of Cleveland, Georgia, is being relocated, and

WHEREAS, said bridge was named for the first soldier killed in World War I from White County, and it is appropriate that the relocated bridge be continued to be known by the same name.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the General Assembly of Georgia that the aforesaid bridge is hereby designated as the "Roy Head Bridge." The State Highway Department is hereby authorized and directed to place suitable markers so designating said bridge.
