EARL NIX BRIDGE — DESIGNATED.

No. 126 (House Resolution No. 462-1117d).

A RESOLUTION

To designate a certain bridge as the "Earl Nix Bridge"; and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, Honorable Earl Nix, a life-time citizen of White County, was killed while working with the State Highway Department; and

WHEREAS, he contributed much to the welfare of his community and served the people of his locality and his State with honesty and efficiency; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of the locality where he lived are desirous of honoring his memory with some tangible evidence of their esteem.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the General Assembly of Georgia that the bridge which spans Turner Creek on U. S. Route No. 129, approximately two and one-half (2½) miles nor of Cleveland, Georgia, is hereby designated as the "Earl Nix Bridge." The State Highway Department is hereby authorized and directed to place suitable markers so designating said bridge.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted by the clerk to the widow of Mr. Nix, Mrs. Earl Nix, who is the Tax Commissioner of White County.
