ALVA J. HOPKINS, JR. BRIDGE — DESIGNATED.

A RESOLUTION

Designating the Alva J. Hopkins, Jr. Bridge; and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, Honorable Alva J. Hopkins, Jr. was a life long resident of Charlton County, having passed away in June of 1961; and

WHEREAS, Alva J. Hopkins served as a member of the State Game and Fish Commission from the Eighth Congressional District for a term of seven years, during which time he devoted his untiring efforts to enhancing and developing game and fish resources in the State of Georgia; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Hopkins served as a member of the House of Representatives and Senate of the General Assembly of Georgia for eight years, as a representative from Charlton County; and

WHEREAS, during his entire life Mr. Hopkins was an outstanding leader in business, civic, political and religious activities in his community; and

WHEREAS, during Mr. Hopkins long tenure of public service, he was instrumental in the construction of Georgia Highway #252; and

WHEREAS, there is a bridge on Georgia Highway #252 spanning the Satilla River; and

WHEREAS, it is only appropriate that this man's accomplishments and public service be recognized in some fashion.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the General Assembly of Georgia that the bridge located on Georgia Highway #252 spanning the Satilla River is hereby designated as the Alva J. Hopkins, Jr. Bridge. The State Highway Department is hereby authorized and directed to erect an appropriate marker so designating said bridge.
