JAMES HENDERSON HALL, SR., BRIDGE — DESIGNATED.

A RESOLUTION

Authorizing and directing the State Highway Department to designate a bridge in Baker County as the James Henderson Hall, Sr., Bridge; and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, Henderson Hall, as he was known to his innumerable friends throughout southwest Georgia was one of Baker County's most distinguished, respected and dedicated sons; and

WHEREAS, he served 20 years as Superintendent of Baker County schools and 16 years as County Commissioner; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Baker County has unanimously adopted a resolution urging that the newly constructed bridge on Highway SR No. 37 in Newton, Baker County, Georgia, be designated the "James Henderson Hall, Sr., Bridge" in honor and memory of this outstanding Georgian.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the General Assembly of Georgia that the State Highway Department is hereby authorized and directed to designate the newly constructed bridge located on Highway SR No. 37, in Newton, Baker County, Georgia, as the "James Henderson Hall, Sr., Bridge" and inscribe an appropriate plaque on said bridge for said purpose.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is hereby authorized and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this Resolution to Honorable Bert Lance, Director, State Highway Department of Georgia.
