

A RESOLUTION BY THE STATE TRANSPORTATION BOARD OF GEORGIA 1984

WILLIAM H. BRANTLEY, JR., BRIDGE — DESIGNATED.

WHEREAS, William H. Brantley, Jr. was an employee of the Department of Transportation, having started work on August 1, 1973; and

WHEREAS, while in the performance of his duties on the bridge by which U.S. Highway 80 and State Route 26 cross the Ochoopee River near Adrian, Georgia, Mr. Brantley was killed in an accident that occurred on March 23, 1982; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Brantley was assigned to the Second District Office in Tennille, Georgia, as a Highway Maintenance Foreman I; and

WHEREAS, it is only fitting and proper that in his memory this bridge on which he gave his life be designated the "William H. Brantley, Jr., Bridge."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the State Transportation Board of Georgia that this bridge by which U.S. Highway 80 and State Route 26 cross the Ochoopee River at Adrian, Georgia, shall be designated the "William H. Brantley, Jr., Bridge."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Commissioner of the Department of Transportation is authorized and directed to place appropriate markers designating that bridge as the "William H. Brantley, Jr., Bridge."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be presented to his widow, Deborah B. Brantley.
