PHILLIP M. LANDRUM MEMORIAL HIGHWAY — DESIGNATED.

No. 25 (House Resolution No. 55).

A RESOLUTION

Commending Honorable Phillip M. Landrum and designating the Phillip M. Landrum Memorial Highway; and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, Phillip M. Landrum had a long career of distinguished leadership as Georgia's Ninth District Congressman for 24 years; and

WHEREAS, during his service in the United States House of Representatives Phil Landrum was a ranking member of the House Ways and Means, the Education and Labor, and the Budget Committees, and his contributions to public policy include his cosponsorship of Medicare and his sponsorship of the Landrum-Griffin Act; and

WHEREAS, Phil Landrum provided direction for important legislation that brought many benefits to Appalachia, including the Vocational Education Act and the Library Services Act; and

WHEREAS, Phil Landrum promoted funding for the conservation of forest lands and was instrumental in protecting the Chattahoochee National Forest, one of our state's greatest natural resources; and

WHEREAS, Phil Landrum was largely responsible for the development of Lake Lanier Islands, and he was a key sponsor of legislation and budgeting for the Appalachian highway system, which has resulted in greater opportunity for economic development in the region; and

WHEREAS, Phil Landrum was instrumental in resolving the impasse over the location of Interstate 75 around Lake Allatoona; and

WHEREAS, Phil Landrum was looked upon with much fondness and respect by those he served and his accomplishments have earned a significant place in the history of our state; and

WHEREAS, it is only fitting and proper that his outstanding record of public service, and particularly his leadership in promoting the developmental highways of North Georgia be appropriately recognized.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the members of this body commend Honorable Phillip M. Landrum for his decades of selfless, unrelenting, and dedicated service on behalf of the citizens of this state.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the portion of Interstate 575 north from its intersection at Interstate 75 to its terminus at Nelson, Georgia, is designated as the Phillip M. Landrum Memorial Highway.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and directed to place and maintain appropriate markers so designating said highway.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the commissioner of transportation.
