WALTER L. HARDIN BRIDGE — DESIGNATED.

No. 17 (Senate Resolution No. 230).

A RESOLUTION

Designating a certain bridge as the Walter L. Hardin Bridge; and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, Mr. Walter L. Hardin was a dedicated member of the Macon police force; and

WHEREAS, his service on that force was unselfish and courageous; and

WHEREAS, such service is evidenced by the fact that Mr. Hardin was killed in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting that in memory of Walter L. Hardin that bridge currently known as the Walnut Creek Bridge on Route 49, also known as Shurling Drive in Macon, Georgia, be designated as the Walter L. Hardin Bridge.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the bridge in Macon, Georgia, known as the Walnut Creek Bridge be designated as the Walter L. Hardin Bridge.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and directed to place and maintain appropriate markers at appropriate locations designating said bridge as provided in this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the commissioner of the Department of Transportation.
