

A RESOLUTION BY THE STATE TRANSPORTATION BOARD OF GEORGIA 1994

PIERCY-HUGHES MEMORIAL HIGHWAY — DESIGNATED.

WHEREAS, Don Michael Piercy and Joey Matthew Hughes died in a tragic automobile accident on July 23, 1993; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Piercy was 19 years old, was a graduate of Towns County High School where he was a member of the football and baseball teams, was a youth leader in his church and active in Boy Scouts, and was employed by DeKalb College in Decatur; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Hughes was 17 years old, was a senior at Towns County High School, was active in his church and was employed by Dill's IGA in Hiawassee; and

WHEREAS, both young men were well-known and respected in their communities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that State Route 288 in Towns County be designated as the "Piercy-Hughes Memorial Highway."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Commissioner of the Department of Transportation is authorized and directed to arrange for appropriate signing for this designation, that a copy of this resolution be spread upon the minutes of this meeting, and that copies be presented to the Piercy and Hughes families.
