

A RESOLUTION BY THE STATE TRANSPORTATION BOARD OF GEORGIA 1994

CHARLIE SMITH, SR., HIGHWAY — DESIGNATED.

WHEREAS, Charlie Smith, Sr., was born in Tift County, Georgia in 1907 and moved with his family at age 12 to the city of St. Marys in Camden County; and

WHEREAS, with only an interruption during his service in the U.S. Army during World War II, Mr. Smith spent his entire career as a banker in the region surrounding St. Marys, organizing the Peoples Bank of St. Marys in 1954 and heading it for many years, and becoming president of the State Bank of Kingsland in 1972; and

WHEREAS, he represented the voters of Southeast Georgia as State Senator for the 4th District from 1959 to 1960 and as a member of the Georgia House of Representatives from 1963 to 1966; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Smith has also been a leader in all areas of community life in Camden County; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate that his service to Camden County and to the State of Georgia be publicly recognized.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the State Highway 40 Spur, located in Camden County, shall be designated the "Charlie Smith, Sr., Highway."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Commissioner of the Department of Transportation is authorized and directed to arrange for appropriate signing for this designation, that a copy of this resolution be spread upon the minutes of this meeting, and that a copy be presented to Mr. Smith.
