

**A RESOLUTION BY THE STATE TRANSPORTATION BOARD OF GEORGIA 1999**

**SOUTH FULTON SCENIC BYWAY — DESIGNATED.**

WHEREAS, Fulton County has applied for Georgia Scenic Byway designation for a 29.8 mile route traversing State and County roads in south Fulton County; and

WHEREAS, this south Fulton County route possesses four of the six possible Scenic Byway intrinsic qualities – scenic, natural, historic, and recreational; and

WHEREAS, Fulton County has worked extensively with the citizens of and organizations in the proposed byway area to develop a definitive route and prepare a Corridor Management Plan for that route; and

WHEREAS, Fulton County has involved the Georgia Scenic Byways Project and Georgia Department of Transportation Staff in the development of the route, application, and Corridor Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, the locally approved Corridor Management Plan incorporates or identifies appropriate strategies, goals, priorities, objectives, schedules, programs, and agreements to protect and enhance the Scenic Byway Features; and

WHEREAS, Section 1047 of the Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act of 1991 (ISTEA) established a Scenic Byways Program under Title 23, United States Code and the Transportation Equity Act For the 21<sup>st</sup> Century (TEA-21) continues the program as amended in Section 1219; and



WHEREAS, the Georgia Department of Transportation is the designated Scenic Byway Agency for the State of Georgia.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that portions of State Route 70, County Road 1391, and County Road 1392 in Fulton County be designated as a Georgia Scenic Byway, and hereafter be known as the South Fulton Scenic Byway, beginning at State Route 92 in southern Fulton County, the route progresses south on State Route 70/State Route 154 (Cascade-Palmetto Highway); thence southwest on State Route 70 (Cochran Mill Road), thence west continuing on State Route 70 (Cedar Grove Road and Campbellton-Redwine Road), thence east on County Road 1391 (Hutcheson Ferry Road), thence north on County Road 1392 (Cochran Mill Road) to its intersection with State Route 70 (Cedar Grove Road).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be spread upon the minutes of this meeting and the Commissioner of Transportation be instructed to install appropriate signs designating this facility.
