

A RESOLUTION BY THE STATE TRANSPORTATION BOARD OF GEORGIA 2000

MISTY NICOLE DAIGLE MEMORIAL INTERSECTION — DESIGNATED.

WHEREAS, Misty Nicole Daigle was born on April 29, 1978; and

WHEREAS, she graduated from George Walton Comprehensive High School on June 8, 1996 and was accepted to Kennesaw State University just three days after she tragically lost her life in an automobile accident on August 25, 1996; and

WHEREAS, she exhibited extraordinary drive and determination by taking on two jobs after graduating from high school to earn extra money before beginning college; and

WHEREAS, she excelled in every class in school and she was able to obtain the HOPE Scholarship upon graduation from high school; and

WHEREAS, she had aspirations of becoming a Certified Public Accountant with a degree in Business Management and desired very much to learn to speak two foreign languages; and

WHEREAS, she was very conscientious about spending time with her sister, whether taking her to the mall or to school, and she was always available to provide a shoulder to cry on or an ear to lend when anyone had a need; and

WHEREAS, it will never be known, because of her short life, to what heights she may have risen and what achievements she may have accomplished; and

WHEREAS, over 500 people requested that the intersection where the tragic accident occurred be named in memory of Misty.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the intersection at U.S. 411 and State Road 136 in Gordon County be designated the "Misty Nicole Daigle Memorial Intersection."

IT IS ALSO RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be spread upon the minutes of this meeting, a suitable copy be provided to the family of Misty Nicole Daigle and the Commissioner of Transportation be instructed to install appropriate signs designating this facility.
