

Senate Resolution 939

A RESOLUTION

1 To designate the intersection of State Route 378 and Petersburg Road in Lincoln County as
2 "Wright's Crossing"; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the house located at the intersection of State Route 378 and Petersburg Road
4 in Lincoln County was constructed by David Blalock in 1792 and has been owned by the
5 Wright family for 150 years and is totally in its original condition; and

6 WHEREAS, the Mildred Estes Fortson Heritage Foundation intends to use the property for
7 a museum of Lincoln County history and a genealogy society; and

8 WHEREAS, this site is an extraordinary example of Lincoln County's history; and

9 WHEREAS, it is only fitting that such an historical site and project be appropriately
10 recognized; and

11 WHEREAS, the Mildred Estes Fortson Heritage Foundation has requested that the
12 intersection of Georgia State Route 378 and Petersburg Road in Lincoln County be
13 designated as "Wright's Crossing."

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 GEORGIA that the intersection of Georgia State Route 378 and Petersburg Road in Lincoln
16 County be designated as "Wright's Crossing."

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
18 directed to place and maintain appropriate markers designating such intersection as "Wright's
19 Crossing."

- 1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- 2 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the Mildred Estes Fortson
- 3 Heritage Foundation.
