- of his community and state earned him the respect and admiration of his colleagues and

- 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 GEORGIA that the intersection of SR 5 and SR 515 in the City of Blue Ridge, Fannin
- 17 County, is hereby designated the A. L. Stepp Interchange and the Department of
- 18 Transportation is authorized and directed to erect and maintain signs so designating the
- 19 interchange.
- 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- 21 and directed to transmit appropriate copies of this resolution to the Department of
- 22 Transportation and the family of the late A. L. Stepp.
