

## **A RESOLUTION BY THE STATE TRANSPORTATION BOARD OF GEORGIA 2007**

### **MILLEN-JENKINS COUNTY SCENIC BYWAY — DESIGNATED.**

WHEREAS, the Millen-Jenkins County Chamber of Commerce and the Millen Better Hometown Program applied for Georgia Scenic Byway designation for a 35-mile route traversing State and County Roads in Jenkins County; and

WHEREAS, this route possesses four Scenic Byway intrinsic qualities – scenic, historic, cultural, and recreational; and

WHEREAS, the Jenkins County Scenic Byway Committee, with the assistance of the Central Savannah River Area Regional Development Center, has worked with the citizens, organizations and local governments in the proposed byway area to develop a route and prepare a Corridor Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Jenkins County Scenic Byway Committee has involved the Georgia Scenic Byways Program and Georgia Department of Transportation staff in the development of the route, application, and Corridor Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, the locally-approved Corridor Management Plan incorporates or identifies appropriate strategies, goals, priorities, objectives, schedules, programs, and agreements to protect and enhance the Scenic Byway features; and

WHEREAS, Section 1047 of the Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act of 1991 (ISTEA) established a Scenic Byways Program under Title 23, United States Code, and the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for User (SAFETEA-LU) continues the program under Sections 1101(a)(12) and 1802; and


WHEREAS, the Georgia Department of Transportation is the designated Scenic Byway Agency for the State of Georgia.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the 35-mile route that begins along Cotton Avenue in Millen's Historic District and continues north along SR 23; then heads west along Perkins Green Fork Road, Big Buckhead Church Road, Old Louisville Road and North Herndon Road and then turns east onto SR 17 back to Millen; be designated as a Georgia Scenic Byway, and hereafter be known as the "Millen-Jenkins County Scenic Byway."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be included in the minutes of this meeting and the Commissioner of Transportation be instructed to install appropriate signs designating this facility.
