Senate Resolution 596, Part XI

Effective May 9, 2022

THE TECHNOLOGY CORRIDOR — DESIGNATED.

A RESOLUTION

Dedicating the Technology Corridor; and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, Forsyth County is home to roughly 8,000 residents who work in the technology field; and

WHEREAS, the City of Alpharetta has more than 700 technology companies and helps support Tech Alpharetta, a nonprofit that mentors young tech startups and fosters tech business growth; and

WHEREAS, numerous technology companies are located along the Georgia 400 Highway, including Scientific Games, Forte Data Systems, New Cyber Source, and Siemens; and

WHEREAS, leaders from the City of Alpharetta and Forsyth County are committed to promoting technology companies and promoting the area as the technology destination of the Southeast; and

WHEREAS, dedication of this route as a highway of progress will promote economic development and attract more technology based businesses.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA, that the portion of SR- 400, from Mansell Road in Fulton County, to State Route 20 in Forsyth County, is dedicated as the Technology Corridor.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Department of Transportation is authorized and directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Technology Corridor and remove any signs in order to effectuate the purpose of this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed to make an appropriate copy of this Resolution available for distribution to the Department of Transportation.

This Resolution shall become effective as law upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Resolution are repealed.
