

RE State Route 18 at I-85 Ramps: Roundabout Intersection Improvement-Lighting requirements

Dear Mr. Moon:


The intersection of State Route 18 and the I-85 entrance and exit ramps is entering the concept planning stage. These intersections have roundabout designs for traffic control proposed as improvements. For this project, lighting is both a necessary component and a requirement. Lighting requirements for this project are based on the Illuminating Engineering Society of North America (IESNA) and American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials (AASHTO).

As a part of this project, the Department is requesting a written commitment from the City of West Point. This commitment should state that the city is willing to share in the costs of the lighting by funding the energy operation and maintenance of the installed system. The Department's responsibility shall be the design and construction of the project, including all materials. Currently, the Department estimates the monthly energy costs to be approximately \$200.00 per month.

If the City of West Point agrees to responsibility for energy and maintenance costs for the lighting installed as part of this project, please sign the attached agreement form and return to our office. If the Department does not receive a written response, it will be assumed that the city cannot fund or participate in the lighting and maintenance costs. In the event the city does not commit to funding the Department may elect to change the scope of the project and or suspend further development of the Project Concept Report.
