## **Project Descriptions**

BR000-0000-00(452) – The proposed project would replace the structurally deficient bridge on CR 164/Sasser-Herod Road over Brantley Creek west of the town of Sasser. The existing typical section is a two-lane rural roadway (one lane in each direction) with graded shoulders and open ditches. The current bridge is 96 feet long by 25 feet wide. Existing right-of-way is approximately 80 feet. The proposed bridge would be 180 feet long by 30 feet wide and would be located approximately 80 feet south of the existing bridge. The project will include a new alignment to correct reverse curves that are too close together at the bridge site. Up to 150 additional feet of right-of-way would be required. The total length of the project is approximately 0.49 mile.

BR000-0000-00(453) – The proposed project would replace the structurally deficient bridge on CR 164/Sasser-Herod Road over Chickasawhatchee Creek west of the town of Sasser. The existing typical section is a two-lane rural roadway (one lane in each direction) with graded shoulders and open ditches. The current bridge is 112 feet long by 25 feet wide. Existing right-of-way is approximately 60 feet. The proposed bridge would be 160 feet long by 30 feet wide and would be constructed at the same location of the existing bridge. The project will include a new alignment on the west side of the bridge to correct a reverse curve at the bridge site. Up to 100 additional feet of right-of-way would be required. The total length of the project is approximately 0.55 mile.

Because the new bridges would be constructed at the same location as the existing bridges, the road would be closed for approximately 9-12 months and traffic would be detoured around local county roads. Terrell County would be responsible for signing and maintenance of the detour route.
