A copy of all comments received will be available for public review at the Gainesville District Office and at the Office of Environment/Location, 3993 Aviation Circle, Atlanta, GA 30336-1593, as soon as compilation is completed.

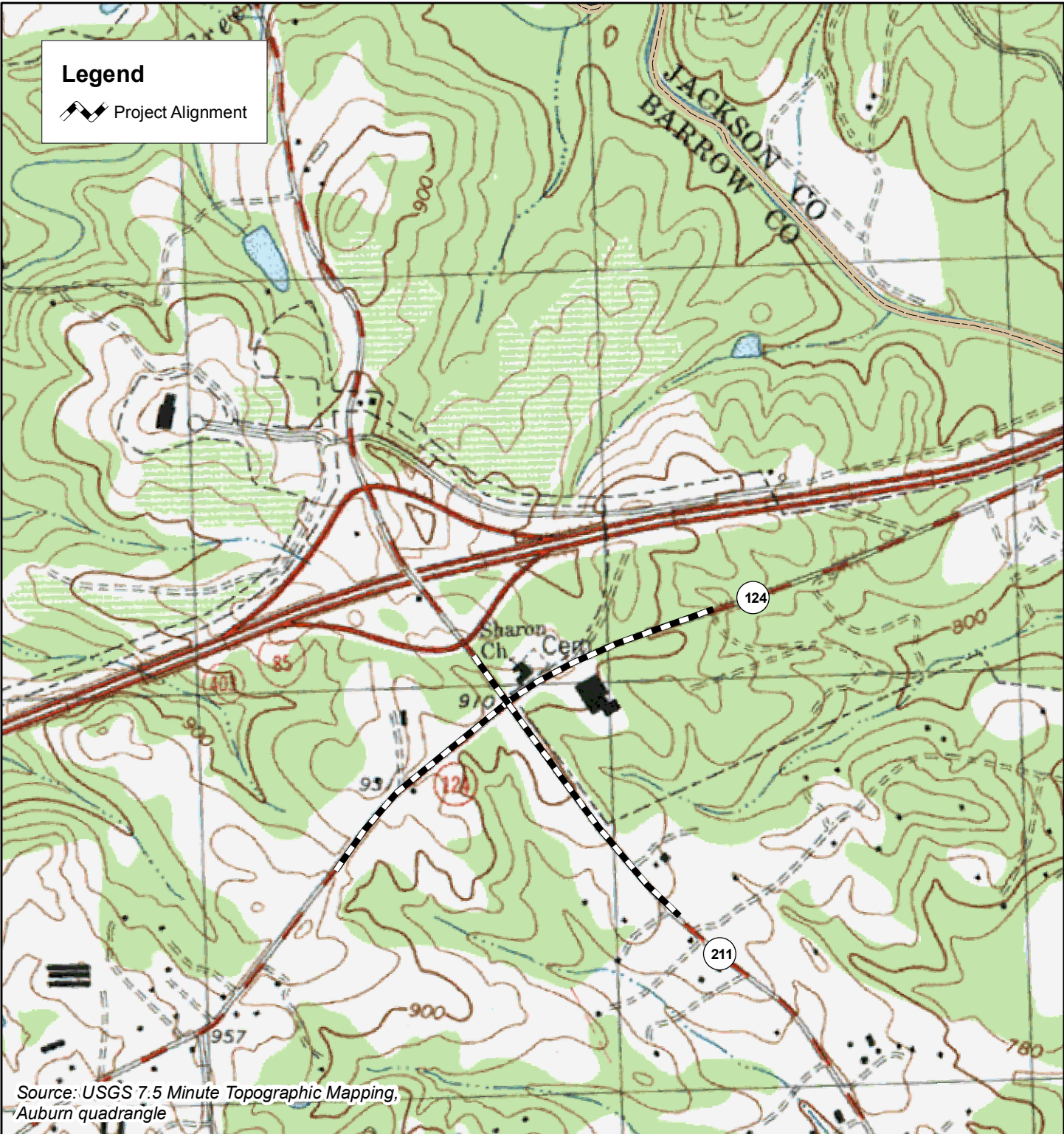

Project Description

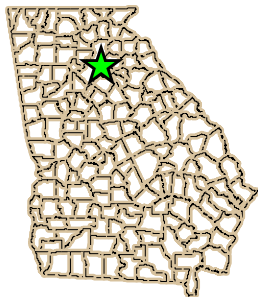
Project STP00-0001-00(038) consists of providing intersection turning lanes in order to improve safety, reduce congestion, and serve future projected traffic volumes. The proposed ROW for both SR 124 and SR 211 varies from 80 to 250 feet throughout the corridor. The termini of SR 124 are approximately 2,100 feet east and west of the intersection of SR 211. The termini of SR 211 are approximately 2,000 feet north and south of the intersection of SR 124. Traffic would be maintained on the existing road during construction.

The proposed typical section for SR 124 is an urban section with a 30-foot raised median. SR 124 eastbound would have two left-turn lanes, two through lanes, and one right-turn lane at the eastbound approach to the intersection of SR 211. SR 124 westbound would have one left-turn lane, two through lanes, and one right-turn lane at the westbound approach to the intersection of SR 211. The proposed typical section for SR 211 is an urban section with a 30-foot raised median. SR 211 southbound would have two left-turn lanes, two through lanes, and one right-turn lane at the southbound approach to the intersection of SR 124. SR 211 northbound would have one left-turn lane, two through lanes, and one right-turn lane at the northbound approach to the intersection of SR 124.
