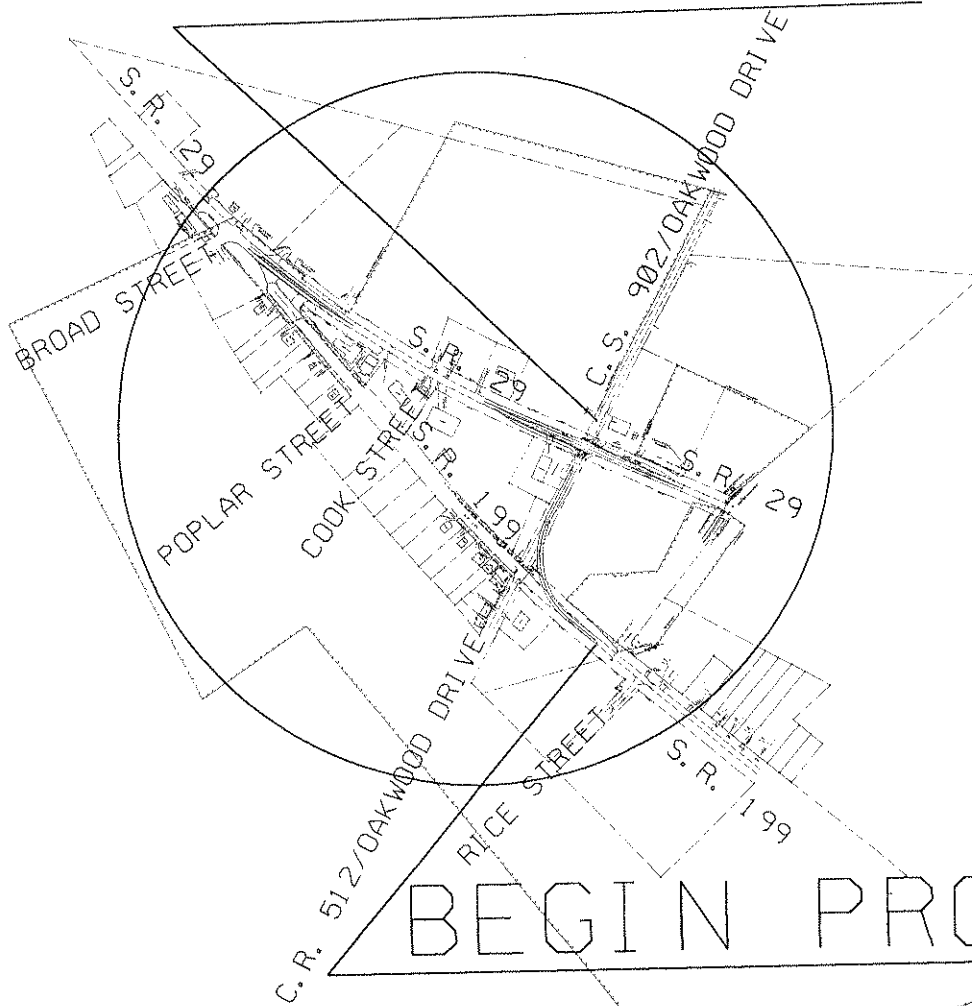

## **Project Description**

This project consists of the intersection improvements of State Route 199 at State Route 29 in the City of East Dublin. This project proposes to realign State Route 199 along City Street 902 / Oakwood Drive to intersect SR 29 approximately 1,500 feet east of its current location. Both State Route 29 and State Route 199 are currently comprised of one 12-ft. travel lane in each direction with rural shoulders and both roadways have approximately 100 feet of existing Right of Way. The proposed project will construct State Route 199 to one 12-ft. travel lane in each direction with a 12-ft. left –turn lane at the proposed intersection of State Route 29. State Route 29 will also be improved to one 12-ft. travel lane in each direction with a 12-ft. left-turn lane onto the newly constructed State Route 199. Auxiliary lanes will be provided where turn movements indicate the need. Strip-tracts of right of way will be required both along State Route 29 and State Route 199 ranging from 1foot to 30 feet. The length of project will be 0.196 miles.
