

NEED AND PURPOSE

PROJECT STP00-0000-00(421), GLYNN COUNTY

The project need arises from the anticipated growth along the corridor and in the area. Rising volumes will create congestion and undesirable traffic operational conditions without improvements to the roadway. This project would add capacity to the existing roadway system and ensure efficient operational conditions along SR 25 Spur into the future. SR 25 Spur is an important link in the roadway system in the Brunswick / Glynn County region and serves as a hurricane evacuation route.

The project would widen the SR 25 Spur from two lanes to four lanes from Cate Road to SR 99. SR 99 would be widened from an existing 2 lane facility to 4 lanes for approximately 850 feet to the west and 525 feet to the east before tapering back to the existing 2 lane facility on 200 feet of proposed right of way. The northern terminus of this project is at SR 99; the southern terminus is near Cate Road.
