NHS00-0001-00(570), Thomas and Mitchell Counties P.I. No. 0001570 Project Description

Project NHS00-0001-00(570), Thomas and Mitchell Counties, is a proposal to reconstruct median turn lanes (crossovers) at various locations on the US 19/SR 300 corridor beginning approximately 3.03 miles south of the Thomasville City limits (milepost 10.50), and runs north to the Mitchell County line on US 19/SR 300/SR 3. The project length is approximately 20.66 miles.

The existing Type "A" median crossovers (adjacent left turn lanes), will be reconstructed as Type "B" median crossovers (offset left turn lanes). All median construction activity would occur within the existing right-of-way and right-turn lanes would be constructed and/or extended to meet speed design deceleration distances at various locations but only if construction can be done within the existing right-of-way.

The existing Type "A" crossovers being reconstructed to Type "B" are as follows:


The following intersections will have dual left-turns:


- 36. SR 122 & CR 385/Remington Ave & Pavo Road

Right-turn lanes will also be constructed and/or extended to meet speed design deceleration distances at various locations. Right-turn lanes will only be constructed if they can be done within the existing right-of-way.

The purpose of this PIOH is to present two median opening locations that will be closed due to the proposed project. These locations are the US19/SR300/SR3 at Marshall Street intersection and the median opening immediately north of SR 111 (MP 31.58). These closures will not affect the function of the corridor or prevent property access.

PROJECT LOCATION MAP


