Thank you for attending the Public Information Open House for the proposed reconstruction of the existing signalization at the intersection of SR 101 (E. 2nd Avenue) and East 9th Street [GDOT Project STP-0003-00(771), Floyd County, PI # 0003771]. All comments will be made a part of the project record. We hope you will take advantage of one of these opportunities to let the Department know your view of the proposal.

The displays and plans will be available for review for ten days after the open house at the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) Rome Area Engineer's Office located at 533 East 20th Street, Rome, Georgia, 30161. A copy of all comments received will be available for public review at these same locations and at the Office of Environment/Location, 3993 Aviation Circle, Atlanta, as soon as compilation is completed.
