Dear Mr. Duff:

I refer to a letter dated June 27, 2017, requesting our verification of a delineation of aquatic resources for your site located along Interstate 16 (I-16) from the Pooler Parkway/I-16 interchange (Latitude 32.0842, Longitude -81.2799), eastward, to the I-16/37<sup>th</sup> Street Connector ramps (Latitude 32.0675, Longitude -81.1173) in Savannah, Chatham County, Georgia. The project also includes areas surrounding the I-16/ I-95 interchange and the I-16/Dean Forest Road interchange. This project has been assigned number SAS-2016-01128 and it is important that you refer to this number in all communication concerning this matter.

The enclosed GPS exhibits entitled "Figure 8A" through "Figure 9AC, State and Federal Waters – Aerial Photography", dated July 21, 2017, identifies the delineation limits of all aquatic resources within the review area. The wetlands were delineated in accordance with criteria contained in the 1987 "Corps of Engineers Wetland Delineation Manual," as amended by the most recent regional supplements to the manual. This delineation will remain valid for a period of 5 years unless new information warrants revision prior to that date.

If you intend to sell property that is part of a project that requires Department of the Army Authorization, it may be subject to the Interstate Land Sales Full Disclosure Act. The Property Report required by Housing and Urban Development Regulation must state whether, or not a permit for the development has been applied for, issued or denied by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Part 320.3(h) of Title 33 of the Code of Federal Regulations).




Figure 9A - State and Federal Waters - Aerial Photography




Figure 9B - State and Federal Waters - Aerial Photography




Figure 9C - State and Federal Waters - Aerial Photography




Figure 9E - State and Federal Waters - Aerial Photography




Figure 9F - State and Federal Waters - Aerial Photography




Figure 9G - State and Federal Waters - Aerial Photography




Figure 9H - State and Federal Waters - Aerial Photography




Figure 9I - State and Federal Waters - Aerial Photography




Figure 9J - State and Federal Waters - Aerial Photography




Figure 9K - State and Federal Waters - Aerial Photography




Figure 9L - State and Federal Waters - Aerial Photography




Figure 9M - State and Federal Waters - Aerial Photography





Figure 9N - State and Federal Waters - Aerial Photography




Figure 9P - State and Federal Waters - Aerial Photography




Figure 9Q - State and Federal Waters - Aerial Photography





Figure 9R - State and Federal Waters - Aerial Photography




Figure 9T - State and Federal Waters - Aerial Photography





Figure 9U - State and Federal Waters - Aerial Photography




Figure 9X - State and Federal Waters - Aerial Photography





Figure 9Y - State and Federal Waters - Aerial Photography


