Resolution

Effective March 24, 1933

**FRANKLIN D. ROOSEVELT HIGHWAY — DESIGNATED.**

**A RESOLUTION**

Dedicating the Franklin Roosevelt Highway; and for other purposes.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA, that the following route be designated as the Franklin D. Roosevelt Highway.

- On SR-13, from the Georgia-South Carolina state line in Stephens County, to the city of Buford; then
- On SR-20, to the city of Lawrenceville; then
- On SR-8, to the city of Atlanta; then
- On SR-14, to the city of Moreland; then
- On SR-41, to the city of Greenville; then
- On SR-18, to the city of Chipley; then
- On SR-1, to the city of Columbus.

AND

- On SR-41, from the city of Harris City, to the city of Warm Springs; then
- On SR-85, through the cities of Shilo and Waverly Hall, to the city of Columbus; then
- On SR-1, to the city of Cusseta; then
- On SR-55 and SR-50, through the cities of Richland and Dawson, to the city of Albany; then
- On SR-3, through the cities of Camilla, Pelham, and Thomasville, to the Georgia-Florida state line in Thomas County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the State Highway Department of Georgia is authorized, empowered, and directed to place and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the road facility named in this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, to transmit appropriate copies of this Resolution to the State Highway Department.
