STONE MOUNTAIN MEMORIAL HIGHWAY — DESIGNATED.

A RESOLUTION

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE STATE HIGHWAY BOARD OF GEORGIA, that the portion of SR-10, from the city of Atlanta, to the city of Athens, be designated as the Stone Mountain Memorial Highway.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the State Highway Department of Georgia is authorized, empowered, and directed to place and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the road facility named in this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution be spread upon the minutes of this meeting.

**STONE MOUNTAIN MEMORIAL HIGHWAY — DESIGNATED.**

**A RESOLUTION**

Designating the Stone Mountain Memorial Highway; and for other purposes.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA, that the portion of State Route 10, from the city of Athens, through the cities of Monroe and Stone Mountain, to the city of Atlanta, be designated as "The Stone Mountain Memorial Highway."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the State Highway officials and other State agencies are directed that on all maps and publications they shall refer to said highway as "The Stone Mountain Memorial Highway."
