

RESOLUTIONS BY THE STATE HIGHWAY BOARD OF GEORGIA 1940

Adopted December 13, 1940

TOBACCO BELT ROUTE — DESIGNATED.

A RESOLUTION

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE STATE HIGHWAY BOARD OF GEORGIA, that the following route be designated as the Tobacco Belt Route.

- On SR-31, from the Georgia-Florida state line in Lowndes County, through the cities of Valdosta, Lakeland, and Pearson, to the city of Douglas; then
- On SR-135, through the city of Hazlehurst, to the city of Vidalia; then
- On SR-292, to the city of Lyons; then
- On SR-152, to the city of Cobbtown; then
- On SR-23, to the city of Metter; then
- On SR-73, through the cities of Statesboro and Sylvania, to the Georgia-South Carolina state line in Screven County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the State Highway Department of Georgia is authorized, empowered, and directed to place and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the road facility named in this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution be spread upon the minutes of this meeting.
