CHARLES H. HERTY MEMORIAL HIGHWAY — DESIGNATED.

A RESOLUTION

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE STATE HIGHWAY BOARD OF GEORGIA, that the following route be designated as the Charles H. Herty Memorial Highway.

- On SR-103, from the city of Columbus, to the city of Buena Vista; then
- On SR-26, to the city of Hawkinsville; then
- On SR-27, to the city of Eastman; then
- On SR-46, through the cities of Soperton, to the city of Statesboro; then
- On SR-26, to the city of Savannah.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the State Highway Department of Georgia is authorized, empowered, and directed to place and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the road facility named in this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution be spread upon the minutes of this meeting.

RESOLUTIONS BY THE STATE HIGHWAY BOARD OF GEORGIA 1940

CHARLES H. HERTY MEMORIAL HIGHWAY — DESIGNATED.

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the highway from Columbus to Savannah, via Buena Vista, Montezuma, Hawkinsville, Eastman, Soperton, Metter, and Statesboro, passes through the heart of the slash pine belt of Georgia; and

WHEREAS, Hon. Charles H. Herty has contributed more than any other person to the prosperity and progress of this section of Georgia through his successful experiments in making paper and various other products from slash pine.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE STATE HIGHWAY BOARD OF GEORGIA, that the following route be designated as the Charles H. Herty Memorial Highway.

- On SR-103, from the city of Columbus, to SR-26; then
- On SR-26, through the cities of Buena Vista and Montezuma, to the city of Hawkinsville; then
- On SR-27, to the city of Eastman; then
- On SR-46, through the cities of Soperton and Metter, to SR-73; then
- On SR-73, to the city of Statesboro; then
- On SR-26, to the city of Savannah.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the State Highway Department of Georgia is authorized, empowered, and directed to place and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the road facility named in this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution be spread upon the minutes of this meeting.
