MARTHA BERRY HIGHWAY — DESIGNATED.

A RESOLUTION

Designating the Martha Berry Highway; and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, Martha Berry devoted her entire life to the education of underprivileged children and provided educational opportunities for rural children; and

WHEREAS, she started with a one-room log cabin and built the Martha Berry School into a multi-million dollar educational plant; and

WHEREAS, many great citizens of this State have graduated from Martha Berry School; and

WHEREAS, said school is located near Rome, Georgia and US-No. 27 traverses part of the property of said school; and

WHEREAS, it is only befitting that some recognition be given to Martha Berry.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF GEORGIA, the Senate concurring, that the State Highway Department and the proper officials of the United States Government be requested to designate the portion of US-27, within the state of Georgia, as the "Martha Berry Highway."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that two copies of this resolution be sent by the Clerk of the House of Representatives to the State Highway Board with the request that one copy be sent to the proper officials of the United States Government.
